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The purpose of this writing is to serve as an annual review and summary of the data specific to PREA related incidents and events for calendar year 2017 at the Glades County Sheriff's Office. This information will also be forwarded to ICE for review, as required by policy.

The facility reports six PREA related reviewed events during the past year. Of these, three were found to be unsubstantiated, two were found to be Unfounded and one was a report of sexual abuse at another facility outside the jurisdictional authority of this office. A brief summary of the incidents is as follows:

The first was a reported allegation of sexual harassment and mistreatment of a male detainee by a male staff member. The allegation was reported to the facility Internal Affairs Investigator, directly. An investigation into the allegations found no evidence to support any of the reported events and the incident was found to be unsubstantiated.

The second involved a report by a female detainee of sexual abuse by a male staff member. The alleged incident was reported to have occurred during a physical Use of Force incident involving the female detainee and several staff members. A formal investigation and review of evidence obtained clearly indicated the accusations were false. The incident was found to be unfounded.

The third incident was a reported incident of sexual misconduct reported by a male detainee against a staff member. The allegation of sexual misconduct indicated that a male staff member intentionally touched the person unprofessionally during a physical pat down. A formal investigation was completed and the complaint was determined to be unsubstantiated.


The fourth incident involved a male inmate reporting he had been sexually assaulted by a unidentified female staff member. The allegation was received on the third party PREA hotline. An investigation into the allegation found no evidence to support the allegation and it was found to be unfounded.

The fifth incident involved a report of sexual misconduct by detention staff at another jurisdictional facility. The information was reported via the facility internal Crime Tip Line. The reported information and statements were obtained and reported to the Agency with the Jurisdictional responsibility to review and address the allegations. No further action taken at this facility.

The sixth incident involved an allegation of sexual harassment of a male detainee by another male detainee. The events were reported verbally to staff. The occurrence were reportedly conversation in nature and no indication or information was given to indicate any physical interaction had occurred. An investigation found the allegation to be unsubstantiated.

In these documented cases, PREA protocols, notifications and investigative responses were implemented. Currently, no further PREA related preventative protocols have been identified for future implementation.
